HOW TO USE THIS WORK

This work may be engaged sequentially or by section, depending on your need and point of entry. While it is structured with progression in mind, each portion is designed to stand on its own and may be revisited as necessary.

As you move through it, write. This is not a passive resource to be read and set aside, but one to be engaged with actively. The value of the work is not found in exposure alone, but in what is processed, recorded, and responded to.

Return to this material over time. What is seen at one stage may deepen or clarify in another. Repetition is not redundancy here—it is part of alignment.

This work may be used individually or within a group setting. When used in community, it is to be approached with the same level of intentionality, allowing space for reflection, discussion, and application without dilution.

INTRODUCTION

Before you ever took your first breath, something was written.

Long before you said yes to Jesus—before you learned the language of the Church or the rhythm of spiritual disciplines—there was a scroll. It bore your name. It carried your blueprint. It held Heaven’s intention for your life.

The scroll is not a metaphor. It is **real**.

And it’s calling you to remember.

What is a Scroll?

In the language of Scripture and the spirit, your **scroll** is the written record of your life as Heaven intended it—your assignment, your identity, your timing, your territory, and your mission. It’s not something you invent. It’s something you **recover**. You don’t get to write it—you get to walk it out.

“All my days were written in Your book before one of them came to be.”—Psalm 139:16

“We are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared ahead of time for us to do.”—Ephesians 2:10

Who Has a Scroll?

Every person—every image bearer—has a scroll.

Your scroll was authored before your birth.

But **only in relationship with Jesus** can you access it fully.

Only in surrender can you **align** with it.

Only in obedience can you **activate** it.

Some people live their whole lives **without ever opening it**.

Others awaken but delay.

Still others burn with the ache of it and don't know what to call it.

This course is about recognizing that ache—and giving it language.

Why This Course Matters

You may have been dreaming things since childhood.

You may have carried spiritual burdens no one else understood.

You may have left churches or rooms feeling like something was missing—but never quite knowing what.

That something was your scroll.

When you begin to awaken to what was written of you, everything shifts.

This isn't about self-help or self-actualization.

This is about surrendering to divine authorship.

Your scroll is not about success. It's about assignment.

It's not about platform. It's about **purpose**.

And it will not be fulfilled through striving, but through obedience.

1 – THE SCROLL IS REAL

Objective

Introduce the scroll concept in both Scripture and prophetic language

Introduction

There's a reason you've always felt like you didn't quite fit. A reason your heart aches at injustice. A reason you've stayed up at night with visions you didn't ask for and fire you couldn't explain. It's not emotional sensitivity. It's not religious overreaction. It's **evidence**—you've been carrying something from before time.

You were written into a scroll.

Before your first breath, before your first failure, before your first “yes” or “no”—there was a scroll in heaven with your name on it. Not metaphor. Not poetry. **Reality.**

You are not here by accident. You are here on assignment.

Scripture Foundation

“Your eyes saw me when I was formless; *all my days were written in Your book* and planned before a single one of them began.”

—Psalm 139:16 (CSB)

“Then I saw another mighty angel coming down from heaven... He had a little scroll opened in his hand... ‘Go, take the scroll...’ So I went to the angel and asked him to give me the little scroll. He said to me, ‘Take and eat it.’”

—Revelation 10:1, 8–9

“He said to me, ‘Son of man, eat what you find here. Eat this scroll, then go and speak...’ So I opened my mouth, and he fed me the scroll.”

—Ezekiel 3:1–2

In all three passages, the **scroll is not just read—it is eaten**. Taken in. Internalized. Lived. The scroll is not separate from the person. It becomes part of them.

It’s the same with you.

Prophetic Parallels

These are common signs that someone has been carrying a scroll—long before they ever had language for it:

- A sense of **divine dissatisfaction**—like you were made for more and can’t ignore it
- An unusual level of **discernment**—you sense things before others do
- **Dreams, words, visions, or burdens** that chase you down even when you try to silence them
- A deep **burning in your bones** that refuses to let you settle

These are not just “personality traits.” They’re scroll indicators. Evidence that Heaven wrote something inside you—and the earth is groaning for you to live it.

Key Definition

What Is a Scroll?

Your **scroll** is the divine assignment written about you in the courts of Heaven.

It is your **destiny, blueprint, and Kingdom function**, and it requires **obedience** to be fulfilled.

Your scroll contains:

- **Who you are**
- **Where you're sent**
- **What you carry**
- **When it's time**
- **Why the war is so strong against you**

You don't get to write your scroll.

You get to *read it, eat it, obey it.*

Activation Prompt

Where have you felt 'born for something' but had no language for it?

Take a moment right now to write it down.

- Was it a moment in childhood?
- A burden you couldn't shake?
- A time you knew something before it happened?
- A moment you felt disqualified even though something inside you was still burning?

Write what comes. Don't overthink. This is how scroll memory begins to stir.

Closing Declaration

Speak this aloud:

"I believe the scroll is real. I believe Heaven wrote something about me.

I say yes to remembering it. I say yes to walking it out.

I will not live beneath what was written. I receive what was written."

REFLECTION – LESSON 1 – THE SCROLL IS REAL

Core Reminder:

You don't write your scroll—you remember it. You don't earn it—you align with it.

Reflection questions

1. **When was the first time you felt there was something “different” about you—but couldn't explain it?**

(Think about childhood moments, dreams, encounters, or burdens.)

2. **Have you ever felt misunderstood, too intense, or spiritually “out of place”?**

How might that be connected to your scroll rather than a flaw?

3. **Which Scripture from this lesson stood out to you most?**

(Psalm 139:16, Ezekiel 3, Revelation 10, etc.)

What did it stir in you?

4. **Where have you felt “born for something” but had no language for it—until now?**

5. **In what ways has your scroll tried to break through—even when you tried to shut it down?**

Personal declaration

Write your own declaration in response to what you’re beginning to realize.

It could start with:

“I believe Heaven wrote something about me...”

“I say yes to the scroll I’ve been carrying...”

“No more delay...”

Bonus

Scroll Memory Triggers

List any people, places, words, or moments that feel like they're connected to your assignment—even if you don't fully understand how yet.

REFLECTION – LESSON 2 - SCROLL ENCOUNTERS IN SCRIPTURE

Objective

Ground the scroll concept in biblical precedent

You're not imagining this.

What you're sensing—what you've been carrying in your spirit without words—it's all been in the Word from the beginning. You are not building your identity on prophetic hype or spiritual mystery. You are stepping into **a precedent set in Scripture** by prophets, messengers, and reformers who were given scrolls... and then sent.

Heaven has always worked through scrolls.

And the people God uses have always had to **eat them** before they could **release them**.

Ezekiel 2–3: tasted, internalized, then spoken

“He said to me: Son of man, eat what you find here. Eat this scroll, then go and speak...”

“So I opened my mouth, and he fed me the scroll.”

—Ezekiel 3:1–2 (CSB)

Ezekiel didn't get a sermon outline. He didn't get a script.

He was given a **scroll**—and it had to become **part of him** before it could come out of him.

The scroll was full of lamentation and woe, and yet it tasted sweet.

Because obedience, even when heavy, is always aligned with purpose.

The scroll was not a document to study.

It was a **message to embody**.

Revelation 10: taken, eaten, then commissioned

“Go, take the scroll... So I went to the angel and asked him to give me the little scroll. He said to me, ‘Take and eat it. It will be bitter in your stomach, but it will be as sweet as honey in your mouth.’”

“Then I took the little scroll from the angel’s hand and ate it...”—Revelation 10:8–10 (CSB)

John was already walking with Jesus.

He had seen the resurrected Lord. He had stood in heavenly encounters.

But **his scroll still had to be taken and eaten**. Why? Because the scroll is never absorbed by proximity. It is received by surrender.

The bitterness in his stomach was the cost of the message.

The sweetness in his mouth was the **presence of the Author**.

And immediately after eating, John was told:

“You must prophesy again about many peoples, nations, languages, and kings.”

Because **scrolls come with assignments**.

Jeremiah 1:5 — known and appointed before birth

“I chose you before I formed you in the womb; I set you apart before you were born. I appointed you a prophet to the nations.”—Jeremiah 1:5 (CSB)

Jeremiah didn't earn his scroll. He didn't request it.

It was written **before he even had a name.**

The scroll existed **before the calling was revealed.**

God doesn't stumble upon your potential—He authored your assignment before your form ever took shape.

Prophetic Connection

In every encounter:

- The **scroll had timing**: it had to be taken when heaven offered it.
- The **scroll required obedience**: it had to be eaten before it could be lived.
- The **scroll released voice**: every person who consumed the scroll became a **voice to nations**, to cities, or to generations.

This is why the enemy fights your timing.

Why he scrambles your voice.

Why he lures you into disobedience or distraction.

Because the scroll you carry **was never meant to stay inside you.**

It's meant to be released.

Challenge:

Where is your scroll hiding in your story?

Take a moment. Think back.

- What dreams have chased you for years?
- What message keeps rising in you when you're quiet?
- What injustices break your heart that others seem numb to?
- What do you find yourself saying, writing, weeping over—without trying?

These are not random traits.

These are scroll hints.

And they've been showing up in your life story all along.

You're not discovering your scroll.

You're finally seeing what was always there.

REFLECTION LESSON 2: SCROLL ENCOUNTERS IN SCRIPTURE

Core Reminder:

Scrolls in Scripture were never just read—they were eaten.

They became part of the person before being released to the world.

Reflection Questions

1. **Which scroll encounter in Scripture resonated most deeply with you—Ezekiel, John, or Jeremiah? Why?**

2. **Have you ever had a moment where you sensed you were being given something “bigger” than you?**

Maybe in prayer, a dream, a vision, or a deeply emotional burden?

3. **What do you find yourself saying over and over without effort?**

What message, truth, or phrase seems to come out of you naturally—like it’s already written inside you?

4. **Where have you encountered the “bittersweet” of a scroll?**

Has your obedience cost you something? What was sweet about it? What was bitter?

5. **If your life so far were a scroll, what would its central theme or message be?**

(Don't overthink—just let what rises come to the surface.)

Personal Journal Moment

Write a memory or experience that might have been a **scroll moment**—even if you didn't realize it at the time. This could be a dream, a moment of deep emotion, an unexpected burden, or a supernatural encounter.

Prayer Declaration

Pray this aloud or rewrite it in your own words:

“God, I believe You have written something about me.

Like Ezekiel, I choose to open my mouth and receive what You've given.

Like John, I will take what's offered—even when it tastes bittersweet.

Like Jeremiah, I believe I was appointed before I was born.

Let me carry Your words and walk in what was written.”

3 – CONCEALED CARRY

Signs You've Been Carrying A Scroll Without Realizing It

Objective

Help participants recognize their scroll-bearing symptoms

What if the ache you've been feeling your whole life wasn't dysfunction—it was design?

What if the very things that made you feel out of place were actually **signs of calling**?

The scroll you carry doesn't always come with thunder or angelic encounters.

Sometimes it shows up quietly—through the cracks of your everyday story.

Sometimes the scroll speaks **without words**, pulling at your spirit until you either surrender or break.

This lesson is about helping you **name the clues**.

You may not have had a name for it then—but that doesn't mean it wasn't real.

You've likely been carrying your scroll for a long time... without realizing it.

Common Signs Of A Scroll-Bearer

1. Sensitivity to Injustice

You see what others ignore.

You feel deeply when wrong goes unchecked.

You carry a **burden** for things that break God's heart—even when it doesn't affect you personally.

You don't just dislike injustice. You feel it like fire in your bones.

This is the scroll crying out for righteousness and alignment.

2. Dreams or Words Before They Happen

You've had moments where you **knew** something before it happened.

You've spoken things others brushed off—until they came to pass.

Maybe you stopped sharing them. Maybe you got labeled or shut down.

But that doesn't mean the scroll stopped speaking.

Scroll-bearers often receive previews of coming things—they carry insight early.

3. Feeling Spiritually “Disrupted” When Others Are Complacent

You've sat in rooms where people were unmoved, but something in you was burning.

You've walked away asking, *“Why doesn't anyone feel this? Why am I undone while they are untouched?”*

This isn't pride. It's prophetic wiring.

Scrolls carry weight—and that weight disrupts comfort.

You weren't made to settle where the Spirit is grieved.

4. Lifelong “Misunderstanding” by Systems or People

You've always been a little “too much” for someone.

Too spiritual. Too emotional. Too intense. Too visionary. Too honest.

You were labeled disruptive in classrooms, problematic in churches, or too deep for your age.

But the truth is—you were carrying something that **didn't fit their system.**

Scroll-bearers are often misread by institutions that can't contain what they carry.

So What Does This Mean?

You're not broken.

You're not late.

You're not making this up.

You are awakening to what's been **living inside you all along.**

The signs were never the problem.

The silence around them was.

Reflection Activity

Write down 3–5 moments from your life that now seem like “scroll indicators.”

These could be moments when:

- You felt something no one else did
- You spoke something ahead of time
- You carried a burden no one understood
- You were misunderstood, labeled, or shut down
- You were overwhelmed with holy fire but didn't know what to call it

These are *not just memories*. They're markers.

Clues that your scroll has been whispering since the beginning.

REFLECTION – LESSON 3: CONCEALED CARRY

Core Reminder

You were not too much. You were just carrying too much glory for the systems around you to hold.

Reflection Questions

1. **What's one moment from your past that now feels like a clear scroll indicator—something you didn't understand then, but you see differently now?**

2. **Have you ever felt a burden for injustice or brokenness that wouldn't lift?**

What was the situation, and how did it affect you?

3. **Have you ever felt spiritually disrupted in a place where others were content or asleep?**

What happened? How did you respond?

4. **What words or labels have been placed on you that now seem inaccurate in light of your scroll?**

5. **Who has misunderstood your calling in the past—and how has that shaped your willingness to speak or obey?**

Memory Markers

Write down **3–5 moments** from your life that may have been **scroll indicators**—whether you knew it at the time or not.

Prayer Declaration

Speak this aloud or write your own version:

*“God, I thank You for every moment You were speaking—
even when I didn’t have the language.*

I choose to see the signs not as wounds, but as witnesses.

I break agreement with every false label and receive the truth of what You wrote about me.

Let every misunderstood moment become a marker of my scroll.

Let every mislabeling be reversed. I say yes to who You say I am.”

4 - WHAT HAPPENS WHEN YOU DON'T ACTIVATE IT

Objective

Address the cost of dormancy, delay, or misalignment

What you carry is not optional.

The scroll written about you wasn't casual—it was **divinely authored** with timing, territory, and obedience in mind.

But here's the sobering truth: **a scroll can be delayed, distorted, or even forfeited** if it's not activated.

Activation doesn't mean striving.

It doesn't mean platform or performance.

Activation simply means you **say yes**—and you obey.

Three Scroll Traps

1. Delay: The Trap of “Not Yet”

Sometimes we sense the scroll but hesitate to move.

We wait for the perfect moment, perfect conditions, or someone to validate us.

But often, delay leads to spiritual dislocation.

The longer we wait, the heavier the scroll feels—because **disobedience produces drag**.

“The time is now...” (Haggai 1:2–5)

Heaven often disagrees with our schedules.

2. Distortion: The Trap of Misuse

Some people open their scroll but begin to operate in it **without alignment**.

They use their gifts for influence, not impact.

They speak prophetically without submission.

They chase platforms rather than presence.

Saul was chosen but distorted his scroll through disobedience.

Samson was gifted but played with the weight of glory.

A scroll operated **without honor or intimacy** becomes corrupted.

3. Disregard: The Trap of Silence

Others simply push the scroll down so long that they begin to forget it was ever there.

But God doesn't forget. The ache may grow quiet, but the assignment remains.

Like Jonah, you can run.

Like Moses, you can argue.

But Heaven will not rewrite what was already spoken over your life.

"I said, I will not mention Him or speak any more in His name.

But His word was in my heart like a fire shut up in my bones."

—Jeremiah 20:9

If you don't activate your scroll, **you will feel it anyway**—as fire, frustration, or fragmentation.

The Bitter Cost Of Passivity

Scrolls don't disappear.

They **burn**.

They ache in your chest.

They show up in your dreams.

They manifest as restlessness, tears, frustration, or deep divine dissatisfaction.

You weren't made to **carry** it passively.

You were made to **release** it actively.

Biblical Examples

- **Jonah** heard God clearly and chose to run. His scroll didn't vanish—it chased him into a storm and a whale.
- **Saul** was chosen and appointed, but partial obedience cost him his scroll. Another took his place.
- **Moses** delayed in speaking, and a generation died in the wilderness.
- **Esther** almost remained silent—until Mordecai warned her:

“If you keep silent at this time, relief and deliverance will come from another place... and who knows if perhaps you have come to your royal position for such a time as this?” (Esther 4:14)

God's purpose will advance.

The question is: **Will you carry your part, or will it pass to another?**

This Isn't Condemnation. It's An Invitation.

This lesson isn't about shame.

It's about **urgency**.

Because your scroll still lives.

And Heaven is ready to breathe on it again.

Challenge:

Where Have You Waited Too Long?

Take inventory:

- Where have you felt the nudge but stayed silent?
- Where have you distorted what God gave you to fit in or gain approval?
- Where have you allowed delay to mask as wisdom?

This is your turning point.

Because no matter how long it's been, **your scroll is still calling.**

And it's not too late to say yes.

REFLECTION – LESSON 4: WHAT HAPPENS WHEN YOU DON'T ACTIVATE IT

Core Reminder:

The scroll doesn't disappear. It just burns inside you—waiting for obedience to give it voice.

Reflection Questions

1. **Where in your life have you felt the tug of your scroll—but waited, postponed, or talked yourself out of obedience?**

2. **Have you ever tried to use your scroll or gifts in ways that felt misaligned or self-driven?**

(Were you chasing affirmation, influence, or approval instead of obedience?)

3. **What are some signs in your life that may reveal scroll-burn?**

(e.g., restlessness, divine dissatisfaction, emotional heaviness, fire in your chest, tears with no clear reason)

4. **What scares you most about activating your scroll—and what truth from this lesson helps you confront that fear?**

5. **Who or what have you blamed for your delay—and are you ready to release that blame in exchange for forward movement?**

Activation Prompt

Breaking Agreement with Delay

Complete the statement below:

“I break agreement with _____, and I realign with _____.”

(e.g., fear, comparison, distraction, perfectionism, shame, disqualification)

Prayer Declaration

“God, I confess every place I’ve delayed, distorted, or disregarded the scroll You gave me.

I break agreement with fear, shame, and silence.

I receive Your mercy and step back into alignment.

5 - SYMBOLIC ACT – NAMING OR SEALING THE SCROLL

Objective

Move from theory to activation

You've heard the Word.

You've seen it in Scripture.

You've begun to recognize the signs in your own story.

Now—it's time to respond.

Because a scroll isn't just something to *learn about*. It's something to *say yes to*.

Throughout Scripture, **activation always required a response:**

- Ezekiel opened his mouth and ate the scroll.
- John reached out and took the scroll from the angel's hand.
- Jeremiah heard his call and surrendered—even with trembling lips.

The scroll is not passive.

It waits to be received.

Why A Symbolic Act Matters

A symbolic act isn't superstition—it's **prophetic agreement**.

It tells the spirit realm: *I've heard. I'm not ignoring this. I agree with Heaven.*

It turns a vague stirring into a decisive moment.

It invites the Holy Spirit to mark this point in your timeline as the place where **alignment began**.

When you activate the scroll, you're not saying, "I know everything now."

You're saying, "I know enough to say yes."

Activation Options

You may do one, a few, or all of these. Let the Holy Spirit guide you.

1. Write the Name of What's Awakening in You

Don't worry about perfect clarity. Just write what rises.

- A phrase
- A word
- A territory
- A burden
- A name

This is not your full scroll—this is the *witness* that something has awakened.

2. Place It in an Envelope and Seal It

You may choose to keep it private for now.

Seal it. Set it apart. Hide it before the Lord.

“Your scroll is sacred. Protect it from premature exposure.”

3. Burn a Match or Light a Candle

Light something as a **sign of your yes**.

This is your fire. This is your ignition.

Say aloud as you do:

“I say yes to what was written of me.

I agree with Heaven’s design.

Let my obedience mark this moment.”

4. Make the Scroll Declaration

Speak this out loud—boldly:

“I receive the scroll that was written of me.

I do not reject it, run from it, or distort it.

I say yes to its weight, yes to its timing, yes to its voice.

Let my scroll speak through my life. Let obedience lead my every step.

I was not born for passivity. I was born for purpose. I am ready.”

This Is A Turning Point. Don't Rush It.

Take a quiet moment.

Let the weight settle.

Let the presence of God meet you in the stillness.

You don't need to understand everything today.

But you *do* need to mark the day you stopped running—and started receiving.

REFLECTION – LESSON 5: SYMBOLIC ACT –
NAMING OR SEALING THE SCROLL

Core Reminder:

This isn't the end of your search. It's the beginning of your surrender.

My Scroll Name Or Phrase

Write the word, phrase, or theme that rose up in you as you listened and reflected.

It doesn't have to be perfect. It just has to be honest.

Seal It

Did you place it in an envelope? Describe the act.

Where did you put it? What does it symbolize for you?

Ignite It

Did you light a candle or burn a match as your yes?

Take a moment to describe what you felt during or after this act.

Declaration Moment

Rewrite the scroll declaration in your own words—or repeat the one below and write any phrase that gripped you most:

“I receive the scroll that was written of me.

I do not reject it, run from it, or distort it.

Let obedience lead my every step.”

Personal Prayer

Write a short prayer from your spirit to God.

This is your moment to express gratitude, surrender, and holy resolve.

6 - NOW WHAT? (NEXT STEPS + PATH FORWARD)

Objective

Give momentum and direction after activation

Now That Your Scroll is Awakened...

Something has shifted. You're not in the same place you were when this course began.

You've moved from **curiosity to clarity**, from silence to agreement, from longing to **activation**.

But this was never meant to be the end.

This is your **threshold moment**—the door opens here, but the road stretches out ahead.

Scroll awakening is only the beginning.

What comes next is everything:

- **Healing the vessel**
- **Understanding the systems around you**
- **Training your senses**
- **Learning Heaven's technologies**
- **Walking in timing, alignment, and authority**

The scroll lives in you now—but it's time to learn how to **carry it well**.

Your Next Step: The Five Technologies Course

If you've just said yes to your scroll, the next thing you need is **spiritual framework**.

You'll begin the next course by learning about the **Five Core Technologies** that govern your scroll and everything around it:

1. **Heaven** – The structure, realms, and divine order behind your scroll

Stay Sensitive. Stay Accountable. Stay Journalled.

Start writing.

Even if it doesn't make sense. Even if it's scattered.

Start documenting impressions, burdens, dreams, verses, and ideas that feel connected to what's awakening in you.

God honors the ones who **steward what He whispers**.

“Write down this vision; clearly inscribe it on tablets so one may easily read it.”

—Habakkuk 2:2

Also, stay **accountable**.

Find one person you can talk to who will **honor the weight** of what's stirring in you.

Final Charge

You're not lost anymore.

You're not random.

You're not too late.

You are scroll-awakened.

And Heaven is now watching to see what you'll do with what you've received. This is your hour. Walk in it.

7 – WHEN THE SCROLL SHIFTS: NEW ASSIGNMENTS, SAME AUTHOR

Objective

Teach that while the scroll of destiny is eternal, it unfolds in stages—through seasons, assignments, and divine pivots.

Introduction

You've been told your scroll was written before you were born—and that's true.

But what happens when your life shifts?

When tragedy, disobedience, healing, or maturity mark you in ways you didn't expect?

Does the scroll stop speaking?

Or does Heaven turn a new page?

The truth is this:

Your scroll is not one-dimensional. It is layered, progressive, and sealed with stages.

It's not that God changes His mind—it's that He reveals the next **chapter** when you're ready... or when the moment demands it.
